1. Policy statement

There are individuals within Cleveland Police who may be vulnerable for many reasons such as: debt, domestic issues, domestic violence, mental and physical illness, suicidal tendencies, criminality, stress related issues, grievances and various other causes.

It should be stressed that these individuals may not always be 'victims' of the actions of others, but could be vulnerable due to external factors, which are not connected to their duties.

It is the intention of the Force that irrespective of the circumstances, once identified, those individuals need to be managed not just for the sake of their families and themselves but also to protect the reputation of Cleveland Police.
