Policy Statement

1. Policy statement

Cleveland Police operates its contract and procurement processes under the Contract Standing Orders of Cleveland Police Authority (www.clevelandpa.co.uk) made under Section 135 of the Local Government Act 1972.

These Contract Standing Orders cover all contracting and procurement activities within the Force. This includes supply, hire, new contract, extension of contract and renewal of contract and/or disposal, with the exception of contracts for the purchase of land and contracts of employment. They apply to all police officers, PCSOs, police staff, specials and volunteers.
