1. Policy statement

The Force recognises the need to ensure a high standard of performance that is consistent across all District Support Units (DSUs). This will necessitate a corporate level of training, equipment and staffing in relation to core functions such as Public Order, Search, House to House enquiries and Disaster Victim Recovery.

Each territorial District in Cleveland Police will maintain a District Support Unit to provide inter and intra Force mutual aid.

Officers posted to District Support Units will be trained and equipped to agreed standards.
