1. Policy statement

Cleveland Police will provide a structure through which the Force implements its response should a major incident / emergency / critical incident occur within the Force area or should the Force be asked to provide assistance to another Force in such an event. The structure is in line with Government Guidance under the Civil Contingencies Act, the ACPO Emergency Procedures Manual and the ACPO guidance on Command and Control. There is a separate force Critical Incident Policy 153.
