## 1. Policy statement

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Cleveland Police is committed to delivering an open and transparent service. The Freedom of Information Act 2000 gives a general right of access to all types of recorded information held by public authorities including environmental information covered under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 (EIR). Any person who makes a request to a public authority for information must be informed whether the public authority holds that information and, subject to exceptions, supplied with that information.
