Government Protective Marking Scheme Policy Statement

1. Policy statement

It is the policy of Cleveland Police to use the Government Protective Marking Scheme (GPMS) in respect of all its information and assets.

Protective marking refers to all information, which includes but is not limited to, physical assets and electronic assets. It relates to the storage, transmission, carriage and disposal of information throughout the lifecycle of the data.

All assets, physical or electronic, must be assessed in relation to its sensitivity and the appropriate protective marking applied.
