1. Policy statement

Drivers of Police vehicles are responsible for maintaining driving standards and adhering to Road Traffic Law when using a vehicle at any time during their tour of duty.

Police vehicles are defined as; those vehicles owned, hired, loaned, donated or leased to Cleveland Police.

Cleveland Police must be able to identify the driver of a police vehicle at any given time.
