Cleveland Police Drone Unit



PCSO Say has recently completed training to become a drone pilot and is currently the only officer specifically for Hartlepool.

Drones can be used to help gather evidence of crime, to monitor ASB, the illegal use of off-road bikes and for missing person searches.

It is hoped that this new crime fighting addition will be a valuable crime fighting tool.

You said, we did

We received multiple complaints of drug related behaviour, violence etc. from an address in Leyburn Street over a period of months.

What we did...

With the help of local residents evidence was gathered to enable the Hartlepool Community Safety Team to obtain an emergency premises closure notice from court.

The address was boarded up for a period of three months.

Ward Priorities

- Drug dealing and drug related ASB – Elwick Road and side streets
- ASB & Disorder – Colenso Street



Crime & ASB figures

In July and August 2021 Antisocial behaviour has dropped month on month from 56 reported incidents in June to 50 incidents in August. This is also a year on year reduction for August.

In July 2021 there were 132 reported crimes in the Burn Valley ward including:

67 reported incidents were violence offences including, assault, threats and domestic incidents.

Theft and handling accounted for 18 reported incidents.

There were 17 reports of both Burglary, 12 Criminal damage and 3 drug related offences.

In August 2021 there were 155 reported crimes in the Burn Valley ward.

79 reported incidents were violence offences including, assault, threats and domestic incidents.

Theft and handling accounted for 30 reported incidents.

There were 15 reports of both Burglary, 15 Criminal damage and 9 drug related offences.

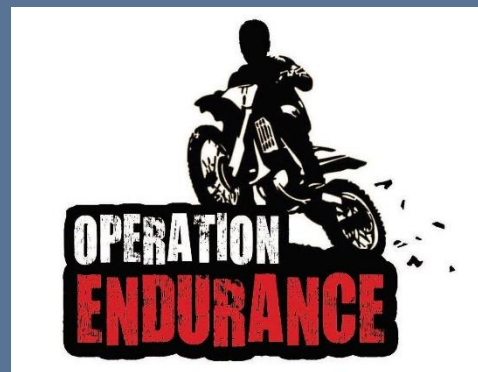
