Over the last few months there has been a continued concern over children climbing on to the roof of the Wok Inn West View Road, although the property is secure and entry hasn't been gained there are clear signs of damage to the brick work and small fires on the roof. Can I ask parents to remind their children of the dangers with this property. There is on going work with the owners and Hartlepool Community safety team and Anti Social Behaviour notices have been issued to a number of these children.

Earlier in the year a family sadly lost their son whilst swimming in the sea off Steetley Beach. Signage has now been placed to remind people heading to the beach of the dangers.



You said, we did

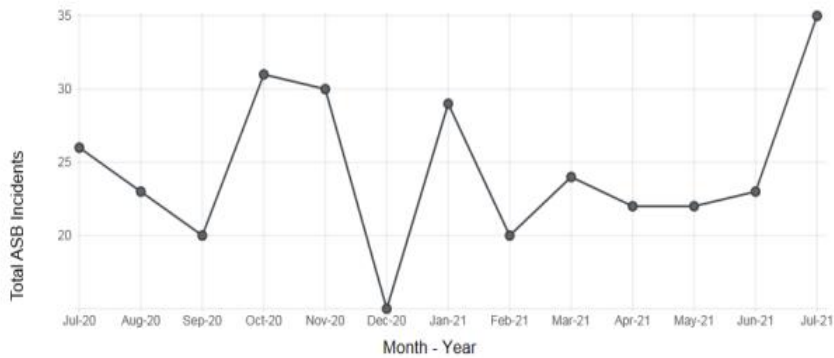
The staff at De Bruce Cour, Jones Road contacted the police regarding concerns for one of their residents who was having issues with young children.

Officers have carried out reassurance visits and patrols at the court with cctv signage and a community safety camera being installed to help assist with any possible future incidents. Some of these children have been identified and spoken to in front of their parents. Further work is on going with Early Intervention.

Pro active patrols are still on going regarding off road bikes within the ward. Any information regarding these bikes and riders would be very helpful.
