Issues continue around the illegal use of off road motorbikes and quad bikes. We continue to urge the public to report incidents directly to Police via 101. We specifically need descriptions of the bikes including riders if possible, addresses where the bikes are coming and going from, and times and dates.

I would like to express my sincere thanks from myself and PC Coggin, to the Belle Vue play scheme who over the six weeks holidays have invited the police in to hold some sessions with the youth groups. We love this engagement with the community and it is fantastic to break down the barriers between children and the police. I aim to keep this engagement a regular feature within the play schemes and I will work with the coordinators to advertise when I will attend the groups. I will also bring with me the property marking machine for anyone who wishes to pop down with any equipment to have marked.

## Main issues raised in the Foggy Furze area.

- Faulder Walk garage parking cars on pavements and causing an obstruction.
- Off road motorbikes and quad bikes in the Studley road area.
- Issues with noise nuisance from Tesco car park and the congregation of vehicles.

There have been 13 ASB incidents across the whole ward.

11 incidents of criminal damage.

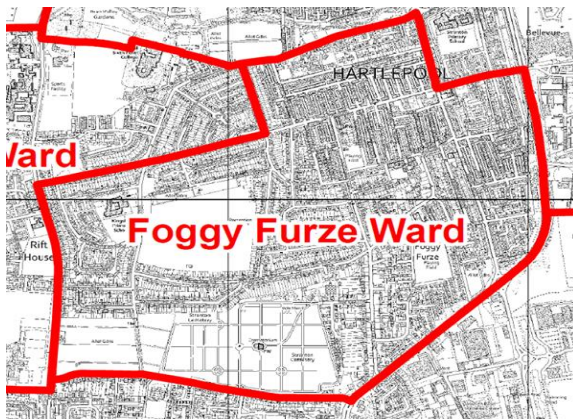
3 burglaries.
